

## PE and Sports provision at Westlea Primary

Amount of funding-£9,000

Westlea Primary is committed to the health, fitness and well-being of all our pupils. In recognition of this-

- All pupils have at least 2 hours of PE a week in curriculum time.
- We buy each new Reception class a PE kit and bag each year (all the school was bought a kit several years ago).
- We have our own football teams and these compete in the local league as well as taking part in competitions.
- We are a member of the local Sports partnership which involves professionals coming into school to do PE sessions with our children e.g. basketball, athletics, rugby, inclusion programs. This also includes access to local competitions in a variety of areas e.g. gymnastics, rugby, cross country. With staff training also being a part of this.
- In addition to the PE curriculum in school we pay for an acrobatics teacher for all year groups across the year and a Baseball Coach in the summer term.
- We also employ a Zumba teacher to do a lunchtime club with both KS1 and KS2.
- As part of our Healthy School status we have installed scooter pods in order to encourage the children to scoot and walk to school.

### Impact

- All pupils take part in at least 2 hours of physical activity a week.
- A large majority of pupils are involved in inter school and across county competitions
- All pupils have a school PE kit so are always suitably dressed for all sporting activities
- 88% of our pupils are at age expected or better in PE (Data Analysis 2013)
