Science	<p><u>Plants, Animals and Humans</u> Watch some of the clips on Education City and BBC Bitesize to find out life and reproduction. Use this link to find them - https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/zgssgk7. Tell your family about what you have learned.</p>	<p><u>Timeline</u> When you were younger, you will have learned about simple life cycles. Now its time to learn more. Think about the six different life stages of a human, create a detailed timeline giving information about each stage of development.</p>	<p><u>Plant Reproduction</u> Find out about how plants reproduce. Look in detail at the parts of a plant, you could draw (or print) and label one. Find out about the different ways pollination occurs.</p>
History	<p><u>Seaham through the years</u> Chat to an older relative, how has Seaham changed over the years? Did you know several films and TV shows were filmed in Seaham? Can you find any other interesting facts about Seaham?</p>	<p><u>Seaham Hall</u> Seaham Hall is a hotel and spa now but it hasn't always been that way. Research the building and see what you can find out about it's history. Are there any other buildings in Seaham with an interesting past?</p>	<p><u>Famous people from Seaham</u> Seaham has been home to a few notable people over the years, footballers, TV stars and writers. Try to find out who some of these were. Choose one and put together an information sheet about them.</p>
Geography	<p>Find out where Brazil is and make a fact file about this place. How many interesting facts can you find?</p>	<p>Do some research about the city of Durham and São Paulo. How are they different and how are they similar? Present your results in a poster or a table.</p>	<p>If you went on holiday to Brazil, what would you choose to do there and where would you visit? Explain why these places interest you.</p>
Art	<p>Research how the coat of arms and originated and how it is used today. Design your own coat of arms.</p>	<p>Imagine you have an empty space/ room. Create you own design for an empty room. Try to be adventurous with your ideas!</p>	<p><u>Dragon's Den</u> You can design your own product (this can be anything you want). Decide on a name for this and what type of product it will be. Create and present a pitch for what your idea will be.</p>
Computing	<p><u>What Next?</u> If you could go anywhere for a day. Research how much it would cost, how to get there and what you could do. Present this information in a way you choose.</p>	<p><u>Concert Coding</u> Follow the online guide at https://resources.scratch.mit.edu/www/cards/en/music-cards.pdf to create your own music performance on Scratch.</p>	<p><u>Sharing Knowledge</u> Write a poem or a rap to tell next year's Class 7 the important points about staying safe when using phones, computers and other devices.</p>
